



Note

The Students and Parents may please note that any leave or Medical Certificate does not entitle the students to claim attendance for the period referred. Such cases also require 75% attendance to be eligible to appear in Internal and University Exams in each Subject.

Leave Rules

No student should be absent from the class without prior permission. Leave, if required, must be taken in advance from the respective HoD. Applications for leave on medical grounds should be supported by medical certificates. However, leave of any kind including leave on medical grounds cannot be accepted as a reason for not completing the attendance requirement. However in such cases, Director / Principal may condone a maximum of 10% shortage of attendance on medical or other grounds as per provisions of IKG PTU.

Use of Mobile Phones

Students possessing mobile phones must keep them switched off during classes/labs/library/auditorium/seminar hall etc..

Carrying of Mobile Phones during examinations is strictly prohibited.

Mobile phone/Laptop/Other Electronic Devices being a personal property, students are themselves responsible for its safety and security.

Carrying of College Identity Cards

Students must carry their I-Cards at all times during working hours. They will not be allowed to enter the Campus or attend the Classes or appear in the examinations without I-Cards.

Internal Assessment & Mid Semester Tests

Each student has to appear in both the Mid Semester Tests (MST) conducted by the institute. The tentative dates for these exams are as shown in the Academic Calendar. Students must take both the MSTs seriously as their internal assessment will depend upon their performance in these tests. The two MSTs will account for 60% of total marks assigned to internal assessment. Remaining marks are divided respectively between assignments and attendance in the ratio of 25% & 15%. First Mid Semester Tests and Second Mid Semester Tests will cover 60% & 100% Syllabus respectively.

General Discipline & Academic Regulation

- All the students are expected to abide by the rules & regulations of the college. Breach of any rule or any other misconduct shall be liable to disciplinary action, including expulsion from the college.
- Disciplinary action, leading even to expulsion from the institute will be taken against a student found misbehaving with any other student or staff members.
- It will be the responsibility of each student to keep his /her parents or guardians informed about his/her progress in the class.
- Students are required to pay semester fees/ other dues well in time to avoid any late fee fine.
- The college will not enter into any correspondence with any person other than the father/guardian, who has signed the student's application form at the time of admission.
- It will be the responsibility of the student to keep the college informed about change in address / contact number of his/her father / mother/guardian.
- While undergoing practical training, the students shall abide by the rules of the organization in which they are taking training and shall be subject to the orders and disciplinary rules of that organization.


